## **Emergency School Closures or Delays Procedures**

Depending on weather conditions or other emergency situations, a decision may be made regarding school closure or delay. The date of a make-up day will be announced following a full-day school closure if needed. If conditions permit remote learning to take place during the school closure, a makeup day will not be needed.

Uintah School District will determine which options will be implemented, but if weather conditions worsen, a two-hour delay could be changed to school closure day. Please monitor your radio or the Uintah School District Facebook page during the morning for any updates or changes. The District will utilize School Messenger to contact families via text, calls, and e-mails to inform of a possible closure or delay.

## **OPTION 1: SCHOOL CLOSURE DAY**

Students and district employees will stay home and participate in school remotely if conditions allow. Extra-curricular activities for Uintah School District will be determined later in the day, according to conditions. Please check the local radio stations and the school district's Facebook page for information on extra-curricular activities and remote learning instructions.

## **OPTION 2: 2-HOUR SHORTENED DAY SPECIAL SCHEDULE** General Information:

- All schedules will begin two (2) hours later.
- Buses will arrive at the bus stops two (2) hours later than usual. (For example, a bus pick-up time at 6:35 a.m. becomes an 8:35 a.m. pick-up time.)
- Half-day kindergarten and Central Cove Preschool will not be held on a shortened day.
   Full-day kindergarten will be held.
- Dismissal of school in the afternoon will be at the regular time.
- Before-school breakfast will NOT be served, however students will have an option for grab and go breakfast in the classroom.

NOTE: In the unlikely event of a district-wide early release due to inclement weather, parents are encouraged to pick up their student(s) from school. Students will not be released before the regular dismissal time unless absolutely necessary due to severe weather conditions.
