- 1. Uintah School District offers Career and Technical Education (CTE) programs in CTE Pathway Programs
- 2. Admission to Uintah School District CTE programs are open to all students.
- 3. It is the policy of Uintah School District not to discriminate based on race, color, national origin, sex, or disabilities in its <u>CTE Programs, services or activities</u> as required by Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, as amended; Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972; and Section of 504 of Rehabilitation Act of 1973, as amended.

It is the policy of Uintah School District not to discriminate based on race, color, national origin, sex, and disabilities or age in its **employment practices** as required by Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, as amended; Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972; The Age Discrimination Act of 1975, as amended; and Section 504 the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, as amended.
- 5. Uintah School District will take steps to assure that the lack of English skills will not be a barrier to admission and participation in all educational and CTE Programs.
