REGULATIONS GOVERNING STUDENTS RIDING SCHOOL BUSES **BUSES ARE EQUIPPED WITH AN AUDIO AND VIDEO RECORDING SYSTEM**

- 1. Students being transported are under authority of the bus driver.
- 2. Bus stops will be no closer than 3/10 of a mile and determined by the number of students and safety of the location.
- 3. Elementary students living less than one and one-half miles from school and secondary students living less than two miles from school are considered parent's responsibility. The only exceptions are in cases of emergency and/or living along hazardous routes.
- Students shall be on time for the bus both morning and afternoon in the morning, five (5) minutes before the bus is due and no earlier. Buses will leave schools in the afternoon seven (7) minutes after bell.
- 5. Students may only ride their assigned bus to and from their primary address, or to a different designated stop on the same route with a note to the bus driver signed by the parent/legal guardian.
- 6. Orderly behavior is expected at the bus stop including, but not limited to, respect for others and private property.
- Students shall remain seated while the bus is in motion, keeping aisles and exits clear.
- 8. Students may be assigned seats by the bus driver.
- 9. The bus driver shall instruct students how to cross the road.
- 10. Students shall not extend their hands, arms, or head through bus windows nor shall they receive or throw anything through the window.
- 11. Students should converse in normal tones; loud or vulgar language is prohibited.
- 12. No eating or drinking is allowed on the bus without driver approval.
- 13. The emergency door shall be opened only in the case of an emergency.
- 14. Students shall keep the bus clean and must refrain from damaging it. Any damage to the bus must be paid for by the student responsible for
- 15. Students shall be courteous to the driver, fellow students and passersby.
- 16. For everyone's safety no hazardous items shall be carried on the bus, including but not limited to animals, insects, skateboards, snowboards, rollerblades, glass objects, flammables, weapons, laser lights, balloons and plants. Students will only be allowed on the bus with projects or treats that will fit in their book bags.
- 17. Students who refuse to obey promptly the directions of the driver or refuse to obey regulations forfeit their privilege to ride the bus.
